**Minutes of ACTC 06<sup>th</sup>Aug, 2019: Swimming Federation of India**

The ACTC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri R.S. Julaniya, Secretary (Sports) to consider ACTC calendar and budget request for Swimming Federation of India (SFI).

List of members present in the meeting is at the end.

2. At the outset Secretary (Sports) stated that in view of the Olympic Games, 2020 the ACTC calendar and budget would be approved up to September, 2020. The budget ceiling would be 150% of the expenditure incurred last year.


3. Sh. R.N. Jayaprakash, President, SFI made following commitments, which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget:-


3.1 SFI would ensure holding of State level competitions as per the calendar.

3.2 SFI would make its best efforts to achieve the following targets:

(i) Targets are based on 2020 Olympic qualifying A time for Men and B time for Women

- 3.3. SFI would ensure scientific testing of all players participating in national camps and international training/events at least 4 times in a year. Parameters for scientific testing would be worked out by SFI within four weeks.
- 3.4. Data would be captured by developing suitable online application in consultation with SAI protecting right to privacy of the player. A robust system would be put in place by NSF by 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2019.
- 3.5. SFI would make its best efforts for early talent scouting. Various sporting events such as Inter-district, State and National Level Competitions and National Open Championship would be for identification of talent. SFI would submit a self-contained proposal for financial assistance in this regard to DG, SAI which would be funded under Khelo India.
- 3.6. SFI would enforce discipline with zero tolerance to indiscipline. In this regard following decisions were taken:
- (i) SFI would adopt a system of registration to register athletes participating in national level competitions and camps. These athletes would be issued photo identity cards displaying their date of birth. Such registration would be valid for five years.
- (ii) No unauthorized absence from national camps would be allowed. No one would be allowed entry after start of the camp. Based on the recommendations of an officer authorized by SFI leave of absence would be allowed only by prior permission of the Head of Institute where coaching camp is organized. Unauthorized absence during dope testing call would be presumed as deliberate leading to consequent action by SFI.


- (iii) SFI would prescribe a proforma for declaration, which would inter-alia include the following:-
- (a) Age
  - (b) Camp discipline
  - (c) Follow No Needle Policy
  - (d) Allow checking of rooms/personal belongings.
  - (e) No absence without permission from authorized officer.
  - (f) Follow the training schedule.
  - (g) Follow the Rules and Regulations.
  - (h) Punctuality.
  - (i) Scientific tests and data use by Govt for analysis and research.
- (iv) If the above declaration is found false, particularly with regard to using of banned substance or cheating on age, SFI would suspend player's registration up to three years.
- 3.7 SFI would finalize its selection policy which would be binding up to September, 2020 and notify the same on its website by 31.08.2019. A copy of the selection policy would be made available to Regional Director (TEAMS), SAI. No change or alteration in the selection policy would be done until September, 2020.
4. The calendar and budget was considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The approved calendar and budget is at Annexure. Keeping in view the Olympic Games, 2020 the following one time relaxations, which would not be taken as a precedent, were allowed:
- 4.1 Relaxation in juniors-senior player ratio for National Camps.
  - 4.2 Relaxation in upper ceiling of days for competition/training abroad.
5. Other salient decisions are as below:
- 5.1 Equipment's and consumables for Swimming to be procured in a time bound manner to ensure timely availability for procurement following to be done:-

- (a) SFI would procure in a competitive and transparent manner. SAI would nominate a member in the procurement committee of SFI.
- (b) For procurement of equipment's a gap analysis at SAI Centre would be carried out by SFI in consultation with concerned Regional Director, SAI. Procurement will be done to bridge the gaps in equipments.
- (c) For procurement of above equipments and consumables respectively budgeted amount to be released to SFI in three equal instalments as grant. First instalment is to be released as advance and subsequent instalments on submission of proof of procurement/utilization certificate. SFI would maintain inventory and record of equipment's and consumables. Any equipment having life of more than two years would be housed in SAI Centres and handed over to SAI Regional Centres where camps are approved in the calendar.
- (d) While procuring equipments and consumables quantity should be used for getting competitive prices but inventory should not be allowed to accumulate. SFI as well as SAI representative in its committee would ensure this.
- 5.2 Equipments procured for scientific testing and gymnasium would be made available to SAI Centres where coaching camps are scheduled in the calendar.
- 5.3 Wherever duration of camp during summer season is more than 90 days and during non summer season more than 45 days subject wise tuition for English, Science and Mathematics each subject would be arranged by SFI or SAI. Upper ceiling for remuneration to a tutor would be Rs.15,000/- month and expenditure would be incurred under national camps.
- 5.4 In the event the player is not eligible for air travel but actual travel by air, reimbursement for travel would be limited to applicable AC II tier rail fare + 25%.
- 5.5 SAI infrastructure and sports facilities, if available, would be provided for State and National level competitions at nominal cost.

- 5.6 Department of Sports would grant necessary sanction for coach, referee and judge development under HRDS. SFI would submit a self-contained proposal to Director (Sports) in this regard. 75% of the cost for upgrading knowledge/skills and acquiring higher level accreditation from International Federation would be funded under the HRDS with the condition that the beneficiary participant pays 25%. In case of SAI coaches remaining 25% cost would be reimbursed to those who succeed in acquiring higher level accreditation along with their TA/DA. SAI would ensure participation of all SAI coaches in the programme.
- 5.7 Coaching camp would not be shifted from the places approved in the calendar. In the event of shifting of camp place additional financial burden, if any, would be borne by SFI.
- 5.8 NADA would arrange for testing of players at national camps and national competitions and gradually expand its capacity to cover state level annual competitions in due course.
- 5.9 National coaches and support personnel required for more than 200 days in a year to be hired on yearly basis and paid monthly remuneration instead of hiring them on daily basis. SFI assured to plan hiring of quality national coaches and support personnel for 4-5 years, i.e. up to Olympics, 2024.
- 5.10 Academies for Swimming at following places are to be strengthened/set up as Zonal Centres of Excellence under Khelo India:-

- 5.11 SAI in consultation with SFI would carry out gap analysis for infrastructure and human resource to strengthen/set up the above Academies before - 11.11.2019 and obtain requisite financial sanction by 18.11.2019.

- 5.12 An amount of Rs. 6.14 Lakh (Rupees Six Lakh Fourteen Thousand Only) was approved for repairing of diving infrastructure at SAI, NSSC Bangalore for holding of 10<sup>th</sup> Asian Age Group Championship, 2019.
- 5.13 Some of the FINA approved competition calendar for 2020 is not yet published. Hence, SFI may be allowed to upload the remaining details of Foreign Exposure/Training on the ACTC portal after publication of the FINA approved competition. An amount of Rs. 3.00 Cr. has projected under Foreign Exposure. As of now exposure amounting to Rs. 1,32,48,000/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Two Lakh Fourty Eight Thousand Only) has been reflected on the portal. Balance amount of Rs. 1,67,52,000/- ( Rupees One Crore Sixty Seven Lakh Fifty Two Thousand Only) will be utilized after the publication of FINA calendar.
